3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Supporting Working
5 Moms Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. REASONABLE BREAK TIME FOR NURSING MOTH-**
7 **ERS.**

9 1938 (29 U.S.C. 213(a)) is amended by striking “sections

1 6 (except section 6(d) in the case of paragraph (1) of this
2 subsection) and 7” and inserting “sections 6 and 7 (except
3 sections 6(d) and 7(r) in the case of paragraph (1) of this
4 subsection)”.

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
