2 Maryland Revised Uniform Anatomical Gift Act – Donors – Registration by Tax Return Checkoff

- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing an individual to make an anatomical gift in accordance 5 with the Maryland Revised Uniform Anatomical Gift Act by indication on the 6 individual's State income tax return; requiring the Comptroller to cooperate with the 7 State's designated organ registry organization for certain purposes; requiring the 8 Comptroller to include a certain checkoff and certain information on a certain State 9 income tax return form; requiring the Comptroller to transmit certain information to the State's designated organ registry organization; and generally relating to 10 11 anatomical gifts.
