- 9 REPAIRING, OR MAINTAINING ABANDONED OR NEGLECTED CEMETERIES;
- 10 (12) PROVIDE ADVICE AND SUPPORT TO ORGANIZATIONS REGARDING
- 11 THE ACQUISITION OF EQUIPMENT NECESSARY FOR THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE

- ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2026, AND EACH DECEMBER 1 THEREAFTER,
- 20 THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT, INCLUDING ANY FINDINGS
- 21 AND RECOMMENDATIONS, TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN

- This title may be cited as the "Maryland Cemetery Act".
- 26 **[**5–1002.**] 5–1102.**
- Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program
- 28 Evaluation Act, the Office of Cemetery Oversight, the provisions in this title relating to the
- 29 Office, and all regulations adopted by the Office shall terminate and be of no effect after
- 30 July 1, 2033.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
