Mr. ALEXANDER (for himself and Mr. CORKER) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To designate the Federal building and United States courthouse located at 719 Church Street in Nashville, Tennessee, as the "Fred D. Thompson Federal Building and United States Courthouse".

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FRED D. THOMPSON FEDERAL BUILDING AND
- 4 UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE.
- 5 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that—
- 6 (1) Fred D. Thompson was first elected to the
- 7 United States Senate in 1994 and served as a Sen-
- 8 ator from the State of Tennessee until 2003;

- 1 (2) Fred D. Thompson graduated from Mem-2 phis State University in 1964 and Vanderbilt Uni-3 versity School of Law in 1967, and served as an As-4 sistant United States Attorney in the State of Ten-5 nessee;
 - (3) Fred D. Thompson was appointed by Senator Howard Baker, Jr., to serve as minority counsel to the Senate Watergate Committee in 1973;
 - (4) following his service as a United States Senator, Fred D. Thompson continued to pursue his acting career, which began in 1985 with the movie "Marie" in which he played himself;
 - (5) Fred D. Thompson was known for his integrity, humility, and dedication to public service; and
- 16 (6) the naming of the Federal building and
 17 United States courthouse located at 719 Church
 18 Street in Nashville, Tennessee, after Senator Fred
 19 D. Thompson would honor his name and the legacy
 20 he left to all citizens of the State of Tennessee.
- (b) Designation.—The Federal building and United
 States courthouse located at 719 Church Street in Nash-
- 23 ville, Tennessee, shall be known and designated as the
- 24 "Fred D. Thompson Federal Building and United States
- 25 Courthouse".
