A BILL

- To prohibit the Department of Homeland Security from requiring vaccination against COVID-19 for essential critical infrastructure workers crossing the border, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Continuing Safe Es-
 - 5 sential Travel Across our Border Act of 2022".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON REQUIRING VACCINATION
AGAINST COVID-19 FOR ESSENTIAL CRITICAL
INFRASTRUCTURE WORKERS CROSSING THE
BORDER.
The Department of Homeland Security, and any
component of the Department of Homeland Security, may
not require an essential critical infrastructure worker to
be vaccinated against COVID-19 as a condition to engage
in essential travel—
(1) from the United States to Mexico or Can-
ada; or
(2) into the United States from Mexico or Can-
ada.
