A BILL

To impose a ban on the importation of certain petroleum products from Venezuela.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Against
- 5 Tyranny and Responsible Imports Act (PATRIA) of
- 6 2017".
- 7 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON IMPORTATION OF PETROLEUM
- 8 PRODUCTS FROM VENEZUELA.
- 9 (a) In General.—No person may import into the
- 10 customs territory of the United States any petroleum

- 1 product described in subsection (b) that is the product of
- 2 Venezuela.
- 3 (b) Petroleum Products Described.—The pe-
- 4 troleum products described in this subsection are products
- 5 provided for in the following headings of the Harmonized
- 6 Tariff Schedule of the United States:
- 7 (1) Heading 2709.
- 8 (2) Heading 2710.
- 9 (3) Heading 2711.
- 10 (4) Heading 2713.
- 11 (c) Rule of Construction.—For purposes of the
- 12 prohibition in subsection (a), the term "import" includes
- 13 withdrawal from warehouse for consumption.
- 14 (d) TERMINATION.—This section terminates on the
- 15 date on which the President certifies to Congress that the
- 16 Government of Venezuela has dissolved the Constituent
- 17 Assembly and restored the National Assembly in accord-
- 18 ance with the results of the parliamentary elections in
- 19 2015.
