| 9 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: |

| 11 | Section 1. Section 2-1-215, MCA, is amended to read: |
| 12 | "2-1-215. Acceptance of jurisdiction over federal lands. The consent of the state is hereby given |
| 13 | to the retrocession of jurisdiction, either partially or wholly, by the United States of America over lands owned |
| 14 | by the United States of America within the boundaries of Montana that are used for national park or military |
| 15 | purposes. The governor is authorized to accept for the state retrocession of jurisdiction." |

| 17 | Section 2. Section 2-1-216, MCA, is amended to read: |
| 18 | "2-1-216. Filing of acceptance of jurisdiction over federal lands. (1) When the state receives |
| 19 | written notification from the authorized official or agent of the United States of America that the United States |
| 20 | desires or is willing to relinquish to the state jurisdiction, or a portion thereof of jurisdiction, over certain lands |
| 21 | owned by the United States within Montana that are used for national park or military purposes, the governor |
| 22 | may accept relinquishment. |
| 23 | (2) After acceptance and approval by the governor, retrocession of jurisdiction becomes effective |
| 24 | upon on filing of the original acceptance with the secretary of state of Montana." |
