A BILL

To amend the Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act to direct the Secretary of Health and Human Services to include data on animal abuse in the national clearing-house for information relating to child abuse and neglect.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Child and Animal
- 5 Abuse Detection and Reporting Act".

1	SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF DATA ON ANIMAL ABUSE IN NA-
2	TIONAL CLEARINGHOUSE FOR INFORMATION
3	RELATING TO CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT.
4	Section 103(b)(6) of the Child Abuse Prevention and
5	Treatment Act (42 U.S.C. 5104(b)(6)) is amended—
6	(1) in subparagraph (B), by striking "and" at
7	the end;
8	(2) in subparagraph (C), by adding "and" at
9	the end; and
10	(3) by adding at the end the following:
11	"(D) the incidence of any such cases re-
12	lated to animal abuse (including any act or fail-
13	ure to act, which results in undue pain, suf-
14	fering, or death to any animal, without regard
15	to whether such act or failure to act is a viola-
16	tion of State or local cruelty law);".
