A BILL

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 1
4503.765 of the Revised Code to create the 2
"Amaranth Grand Chapter Order of the Eastern 3
Star" license plate. 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section 5
4503.765 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 6

Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state 7
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall 8
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants 9
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to 10
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.495, 11
4503.496, 4503.497, 4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 12
4503.502, 4503.505, 4503.51, 4503.514, 4503.521, 4503.522, 13
4503.523, 4503.524, 4503.525, 4503.526, 4503.528, 4503.529, 14
4503.531, 4503.534, 4503.545, 4503.55, 4503.551, 4503.552, 15
4503.553, 4503.554, 4503.555, 4503.556, 4503.561, 4503.562, 16
4503.564, 4503.565, 4503.576, 4503.577, 4503.591, 4503.592, 17
4503.67, 4503.68, 4503.69, 4503.701, 4503.702, 4503.71, 18
4503.711, 4503.712, 4503.713, 4503.715, 4503.72, 4503.722, 19

4503.98 of the Revised Code. 24

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the 25
registrar collects in the fund as follows: 26

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 27
pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast 28
cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for 29
programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast 30
cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to 31
quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of 32
the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or 33
other abortion-related activities. 34

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 35
receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the 36
organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall 37
deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that 38
organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend 39
the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same 40
manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends 41
other money in that fund. 42

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 43
pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism 44
society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs 45
and autism awareness efforts throughout the state. 46

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 47
receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the 48

national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal 49
amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley 50
chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These 51
chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to 52
assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services 53
directly to their clients. 54

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 55
receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the 56
national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money 57
it receives under this section to assist those who suffer with 58
pancreatic cancer and their families. 59

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 60
receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the 61
Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the 62
contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social 63
support services for adults who have sickle cell disease. 64

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 65
receives pursuant to section 4503.497 of the Revised Code to the 66
St. Baldrick's foundation, which shall use the contributions for 67
its research and other programs. 68

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 69
receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to 70
special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions 71
for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities. 72

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 73
receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the 74
children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the 75
contributions for its research and other programs. 76

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 77

receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 78
future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 79
contributions into its general account to be used for 80
educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 81
America foundation. 82

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 83
receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 84
4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university 85
extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay 86
the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities. 87

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 88
pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 89
cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 90
scholarships and other educational activities. 91

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 92
pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 93
organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 94
contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 95
that organization. 96

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 97
receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 98
university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 99
collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 100
section. A university or college that receives contributions 101
from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 102
scholarship fund. 103

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 104
receives pursuant to section 4503.514 of the Revised Code to the 105
university of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana, for purposes of 106

awarding grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who attend 107
the university. The university shall not use any of the funds it 108
receives for purposes of administering the scholarship program. 109
The registrar shall enter into appropriate agreements with the 110
university of Notre Dame to effectuate the distribution of such 111
funds as provided in this section. 112

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 113
receives pursuant to section 4503.521 of the Revised Code to the 114
Ohio bicycle federation to assist that organization in paying 115
for the educational programs it sponsors in support of Ohio 116
cyclists of all ages. 117

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 118
receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the 119
"friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, 120
incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws 121
of this state, to assist that organization in paying the 122
expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, 123
educational, and cultural events at the monument. 124

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 125
receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 126
fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 127
the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 128
lighthouses of fairport harbor. 129

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 130
receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the 131
Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the 132
contributions only to promote and support the football team of 133
Washington high school of the Massillon city school district. 134

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 135

receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the 136
United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty- 137
four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron 138
district shall use the money it receives under this section to 139
pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or 140
sponsors within this state. 141

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 142
receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 143
Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 144
international, which shall use the money it receives under this 145
section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian 146
activities. 147

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 148
receives pursuant to section 4503.528 of the Revised Code to the 149
Ohio association of child caring agencies, which shall use the 150
money it receives under this section to pay the expenses it 151
incurs in advancing its mission of sustainably improving the 152
provision of services to children, young adults, and families in 153
this state. 154

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 155
receives pursuant to section 4503.529 of the Revised Code to the 156
Ohio nurses foundation. The foundation shall use the money it 157
receives under this section to provide educational scholarships 158
to assist individuals who aspire to join the nursing profession, 159
to assist nurses in the nursing profession who seek to advance 160
their education, and to support persons conducting nursing 161
research concerning the evidence-based practice of nursing and 162
the improvement of patient outcomes. 163

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 164
receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the 165

thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation 166
organized under the laws of this state, to assist that 167
organization in paying for the charitable activities and 168
programs it sponsors in support of United States military 169
personnel, veterans, and their families. 170

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 171
receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 172
disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 173
programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 174
families. 175

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 176
receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 177
pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 178
into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 179
be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 180
hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 181
of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 182
destination. 183

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to 184
the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code 185
to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use 186
the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and 187
programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state. 188

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 189
contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 190
4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 191
source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 192
designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 193
Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 194
section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 195

cats and for educational programs concerning the proper 196
veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio 197
pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and 198
maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties. 199

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 200
receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the 201
rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated. 202

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 203
receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the 204
Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit 205
corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 206
the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the 207
members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 208
charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 209
provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 210
Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 211
for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 212
promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 213
incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 214
under this section. 215

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 216
receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 217
Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 218
the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 219
programs. 220

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 221
receives pursuant to section 4503.555 of the Revised Code to the 222
western reserve historical society, which shall use the 223
contributions to fund the Crawford auto aviation museum. 224

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 225
receives pursuant to section 4503.556 of the Revised Code to the 226
Erica J. Holloman foundation, inc., for the awareness of triple 227
negative breast cancer. The foundation shall use the 228
contributions for charitable and educational purposes. 229

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 230
receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 231
state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 232
deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 233
establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 234
distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 235
ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 236
for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 237
managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 238
Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 239
registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 240
such payments are to be made. 241

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 242
receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the 243
Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the 244
expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning 245
river watershed. 246

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 247
receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to 248
Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute 249
to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve. 250

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 251
receives pursuant to section 4503.565 of the Revised Code to the 252
conservancy for Cuyahoga valley national park, which shall use 253
the money in support of the park. 254

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational information about beekeeping, and to support other state and local beekeeping programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.577 of the Revised Code to the national aviation hall of fame, which shall use the contributions to fulfill its mission of honoring aerospace legends to inspire future leaders.

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each contribution the registrar receives under that section that an applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a professional sports team located in the county of that sports commission and that is participating in the license plate program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective of the county of residence of an applicant.

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is participating in the license plate program pursuant to division (G) of that section.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.592 of the Revised Code to pollinator partnership's monarch wings across Ohio program, which shall use the contributions for the protection and preservation of the monarch butterfly and pollinator corridor in

Ohio and for educational programs. 285

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 286
receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the 287
Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 288
shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner 289
throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts. 290

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 291
receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the 292
great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of 293
America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an 294
equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of 295
the girl scouts. 296

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 297
receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the 298
Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 299
shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner 300
throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts. 301

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 302
receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the 303
Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio, 304
which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes. 305

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 306
receives pursuant to section 4503.702 of the Revised Code to the 307
Ohio Association of the Improved Benevolent and Protective Order 308
of the Elks of the World, which shall use the funds for 309
charitable purposes. 310

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 311
receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the 312
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 313

deposit the fees into its general account to be used for 314
purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated. 315

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 316
receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the 317
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 318
deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be 319
used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law 320
enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement 321
methods, and teaching respect for law and order. 322

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 323
pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio 324
concerns of police survivors, which shall use those 325
contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate 326
to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed 327
in the line of duty. 328

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 329
pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater 330
Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those 331
contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in 332
the line of duty and support its charitable purposes. 333

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 334
receives pursuant to section 4503.715 of the Revised Code to the 335
fallen linemen organization, which shall use the contributions 336
to recognize and memorialize fallen linemen and support their 337
families. 338

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 339
receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 340
organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 341
association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 342

Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 343
shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 344
administering a program to secure the proper representation in 345
the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 346
children, and for the training and supervision of persons 347
participating in that program. 348

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 349
receives pursuant to section 4503.722 of the Revised Code to the 350
Down Syndrome Association of Central Ohio, which shall use the 351
contributions for advocacy purposes throughout the state. 352

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 353
receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to 354
Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the 355
contributions into its general account to be used for purposes 356
of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated. 357

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 358
receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 359
Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 360
commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 361
Cleveland, Ohio. 362

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 363
receives pursuant to section 4503.733 of the Revised Code to the 364
Ohio chapter of the juvenile diabetes research foundation in 365
whose geographic territory the person who paid the contribution 366
resides. 367

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 368
receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the 369
Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the 370
moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 371

4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written 372
agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos. 373

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 374
receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the 375
rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, 376
Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and 377
used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the 378
rotary foundation. 379

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 380
receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the 381
Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the 382
contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained 383
under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation. 384

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 385
receives pursuant to section 4503.752 of the Revised Code to 386
buckeye corvettes, incorporated, which shall use the 387
contributions to pay for its charitable activities and programs. 388

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 389
receives pursuant to section 4503.763 of the Revised Code to the 390
Ohio history connection to be used solely to build, support, and 391
maintain the Ohio battleflag collection within the Ohio history 392
connection. 393

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 394
receives pursuant to section 4503.765 of the Revised Code to the 395
Amaranth grand chapter foundation, which shall use the 396
contributions for communal outreach, charitable service, and 397
scholarship purposes. 398

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 399
receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the 400

Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area 401
research projects. 402

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 403
receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the 404
Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those 405
contributions solely to promote and support the historical 406
preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this 407
state. 408

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 409
receives pursuant to section 4503.87 of the Revised Code to the 410
Grove City little league dream field fund, which shall use those 411
contributions solely to build, maintain, and improve youth 412
baseball fields within the municipal corporation of Grove City. 413

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 414
receives pursuant to section 4503.871 of the Revised Code to the 415
Solon city school district. The school district shall use the 416
contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs in 417
providing services to the school district's students that assist 418
in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being 419
of the students. The services provided may include bereavement 420
counseling, instruction in defensive driving techniques, 421
sensitivity training, and the counseling and education of 422
students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug abuse, 423
suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school district 424
superintendent or, in the school district superintendent's 425
discretion, the appropriate school principal or appropriate 426
school counselors shall determine any charitable organizations 427
that the school district hires to provide those services. The 428
school district also may use the contributions it receives to 429
pay for members of the faculty of the school district to receive 430

training in providing such services to the students of the 431
school district. The school district shall ensure that any 432
charitable organization that is hired by the district is exempt 433
from federal income taxation under subsection 501(c)(3) of the 434
Internal Revenue Code. The school district shall not use the 435
contributions it receives for any other purpose. 436

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 437
receives pursuant to section 4503.874 of the Revised Code to St. 438
Edward high school located in the municipal corporation of 439
Lakewood. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 440
contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its 441
students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to 442
pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's 443
students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 444
emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 445
include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 446
techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 447
education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 448
abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 449
providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 450
faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 451
services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 452
discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 453
charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 454
services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 455
organization is exempt from federal income taxation under 456
subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school 457
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 458
purpose. 459

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 460
receives pursuant to section 4503.877 of the Revised Code to the 461

Independence local school district. The school district shall 462
use the contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs 463
in providing services to the school district's students that 464
assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional 465
well-being of the students. The services provided may include 466
bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 467
techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 468
education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 469
abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school 470
district superintendent or, in the school district 471
superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 472
appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 473
organizations that the school district hires to provide those 474
services. The school district also may use the contributions it 475
receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 476
district to receive training in providing such services to the 477
students of the school district. The school district shall 478
ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 479
district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 480
501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 481
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 482
purpose. 483

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 484
receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 485
American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 486
chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 487
contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 488
programs on a statewide basis. 489

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 490
receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the 491
nationwide children's hospital foundation. 492

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.901 of the Revised Code to the Ohio association for pupil transportation, which shall use the money to support transportation programs, provide training to school transportation professionals, and support other initiatives for school transportation safety.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.902 of the Revised Code to St. Ignatius high school located in the municipal corporation of Cleveland. The school shall use fifty per cent of the contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of providing such services, the school may pay for members of the faculty of the school to receive training in providing those services. The school principal or, in the school principal's discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable organization is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school shall not use the contributions it receives for any other purpose.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.903 of the Revised Code to the

district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the 525

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 589

city of Westerville's vision of becoming "A City Within A Park." 593

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate 594
contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than 595
the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall 596
distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this 597
section the investment income the fund earned the previous 598
calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an 599
entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity 600

Sec. 4503.765. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger 602
car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other 603
vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles 604
may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle 605
and issuance of "Amaranth Grand Chapter Order of the Eastern 606
Star" license plates. The application may be combined with a 607
request for a special reserved license plate under section 608
4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code. Upon receipt of the 609
completed application and compliance by the applicant with 610
divisions (B) and (C) of this section, the registrar shall issue 611
to the applicant the appropriate vehicle registration and a set 612
of "Amaranth Grand Chapter Order of the Eastern Star" license 613
plates and a validation sticker, or a validation sticker alone 614

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In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily
inscribed on the license plates, "Amaranth Grand Chapter Order
of the Eastern Star" license plates shall display an appropriate
logo and words selected by representatives of the Amaranth grand
chapter foundation and that are approved by the registrar.
"Amaranth Grand Chapter Order of the Eastern Star" license
plates shall display county identification stickers that
identify the county of registration as required under section
4503.19 of the Revised Code.

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(B) "Amaranth Grand Chapter Order of the Eastern Star"
license plates and a validation sticker, or a validation sticker
alone, shall be issued upon receipt of an application for
registration of a motor vehicle under this section; payment of
the regular license tax as prescribed under section 4503.04 of
the Revised Code, any applicable motor vehicle license tax
levied under Chapter 4504. of the Revised Code, any applicable
additional fee prescribed by section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the

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(C) (1) For each application for registration and

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(2) The registrar shall deposit the administrative fee of
ten dollars, the purpose of which is to compensate the bureau of

plates, into the state treasury to the credit of the public 647
safety - highway purposes fund created in section 4501.06 of the 648
