A BILL

To prohibit the use of Federal funds to maintain or collect information that can be used to identify any individual to whom a COVID–19 vaccine is administered, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITING MAINTENANCE OR COLLECTION**
4 **OF INFORMATION IDENTIFYING COVID–19**
5 **VACCINE RECIPIENTS.**

6 No funds may be obligated or expended by the Fed-
7 eral Government, including the Centers for Disease Con-
8 trol and Prevention, to maintain a database of, or collect,

1 information that can be used to identify an individual to
2 whom is administered a vaccine that is intended to pre-
3 vent, mitigate, or treat the virus that causes COVID-19.

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
