

1 AN ACT relating to days of remembrance.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 2 IS CREATED TO
4 READ AS FOLLOWS:

5 ***The following days of remembrance and honor shall be observed in the***
6 ***Commonwealth:***

7 ***(1) The nineteenth day of August (Battle of Blue Licks Day);***

8 ***(2) The first day of June (Statehood Day);***

9 ***(3) The nineteenth day of January (Battle of Mill Springs Day);***

10 ***(4) The thirtieth day of August (Battle of Richmond Day);***

11 ***(5) The seventeenth day of September (Battle of Munfordville Day); and***

12 ***(6) The eighth day of October (Battle of Perryville Day).***

13 ➔Section 2. KRS 2.110 is amended to read as follows:

14 (1) The first day of January (New Year's Day), the third Monday of January (Birthday
15 of Martin Luther King, Jr.), ~~the nineteenth day of January (Robert E. Lee Day), the~~
16 ~~thirtieth day of January (Franklin D. Roosevelt Day)~~, the twelfth day of February
17 (Lincoln's Birthday), the third Monday in February (Washington's Birthday), the last
18 Monday in May (Memorial Day), ~~the third day of June (Confederate Memorial~~
19 ~~Day, and Jefferson Davis Day)~~, the fourth day of July (Independence Day), the first
20 Monday in September (Labor Day), the second Monday in October (Columbus
21 Day), the eleventh day of November (Veterans Day), the twenty-fifth day of
22 December (Christmas Day) of each year, and all days appointed by the President of
23 the United States or by the Governor as days of thanksgiving, are holidays, on
24 which all the public offices of this Commonwealth may be closed.

25 (2) No person shall be compelled to labor on the first Monday in September (Labor
26 Day) by any person.
