A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to carry out a pilot program to provide access to magnetic EEG/ EKG-guided resonance therapy to veterans.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "No Hero Left Un-
- 3 treated Act".

4 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.

- 5 Congress finds the following:
- 6 (1) Magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance ther7 apy has successfully treated more than 400 veterans
 8 with post-traumatic stress disorder, traumatic brain
 9 injury, military sexual trauma, chronic pain, and
 10 opiate addiction.
 - (2) Recent clinical trials and randomized, placebo-controlled, double-blind studies have produced promising measurable outcomes in the evolution of magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy.
 - (3) The outcomes described in paragraph (2) have resulted in escalating demand from returning members of the Armed Forces and veterans who are seeking access to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy.
 - (4) Congress recognizes the importance of initiating innovative pilot programs that demonstrate the use and effectiveness of new treatment options for post-traumatic stress disorder, traumatic brain injury, military sexual trauma, chronic pain, and opiate addiction.

1 SEC. 3. MAGNETIC EEG/EKG-GUIDED RESONANCE THERAPY

- 2 PILOT PROGRAM.
- 3 (a) PILOT PROGRAM.—Commencing not later than
- 4 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
- 5 Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall carry out a pilot pro-
- 6 gram to provide access to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided res-
- 7 onance therapy to treat veterans suffering from post-trau-
- 8 matic stress disorder, traumatic brain injury, military sex-
- 9 ual trauma, chronic pain, or opiate addiction.
- 10 (b) Locations.—The Secretary shall carry out the
- 11 pilot program under subsection (a) at not more than two
- 12 facilities of the Department of Veterans Affairs.
- 13 (c) Participants.—In carrying out the pilot pro-
- 14 gram under subsection (a), the Secretary shall provide ac-
- 15 cess to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy to
- 16 not more than 50 veterans.
- 17 (d) Duration.—The Secretary shall carry out the
- 18 pilot program under subsection (a) for a one-year period.
- 19 (e) Report.—Not later than 90 days after the termi-
- 20 nation of the pilot program under subsection (d), the Sec-
- 21 retary shall submit to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs
- 22 of the Senate and the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of
- 23 the House of Representatives a report on the pilot pro-
- 24 gram.
- 25 (f) No Authorization of Appropriations.—No
- 26 additional amounts are authorized to be appropriated to

- 1 carry out the requirements of this section. Such require-
- 2 ments shall be carried out using amounts authorized

3 under provisions of law other than this section.
