14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17	7–136.
18	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "INSTRUCTIONAL TIME" MEANS ANY TIME DURING THE SCHOOL DAY, EXCEPT A STUDENT'S LUNCH PERIOD.
20 21	(B) NOT LATER THAN THE 2026–2027 SCHOOL YEAR, EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A POLICY TO LIMIT THE USE OF CELLULAR PHONES BY STUDENTS DUPING INSTRUCTIONAL TIME



- 1 (C) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, THE 2 POLICY DEVELOPED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:
- 3 (1) PROHIBIT A STUDENT FROM USING A CELLULAR PHONE DURING 4 INSTRUCTIONAL TIME;
- 5 (2) REQUIRE A STUDENT TO STORE THE STUDENT'S CELLULAR 6 PHONE IN A SECURE PLACE DURING INSTRUCTIONAL TIME; AND
- 7 (3) PROHIBIT A STUDENT FROM USING THE SOCIAL MEDIA 8 APPLICATIONS AND SOCIAL MEDIA WEBSITES DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD 9 DURING SCHOOL HOURS.
- 10 **(D)** THE POLICY DEVELOPED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT PROHIBIT A STUDENT FROM USING A CELLULAR PHONE:
- 12 (1) FOR ANY PURPOSE DOCUMENTED IN THE STUDENT'S 13 INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM OR SECTION 504 PLAN;
- 14 (2) TO MONITOR OR ADDRESS A STUDENT'S DOCUMENTED HEALTH 15 ISSUE;
- 16 **(3) DURING AN EMERGENCY EVENT; OR**
- 17 (4) When directed by an educator or administrator for 18 educational purposes.
- 19 **(E) (1)** A POLICY DEVELOPED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE 20 APPROPRIATE DISCIPLINARY MEASURES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE POLICY, 21 INCLUDING A WARNING FOR AN INITIAL VIOLATION.
- 22 (2) THE DISCIPLINARY MEASURES ADOPTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) 23 OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE ENFORCED BY AN ADMINISTRATOR.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
