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## A BILL

To extend certain provisions of the Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Act until September 30, 2030, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Extension of the Carib-  
5 bean Basin Economic Recovery Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF THE CARIBBEAN BASIN ECONOMIC**  
7 **RECOVERY ACT.**

8 Section 213 of the Caribbean Basin Economic Recov-  
9 ery Act (19 U.S.C. 2703) is amended as follows:

1           (1) EXTENSION FOR CERTAIN KNIT APPAREL  
2 ARTICLES.—In clause (iii) of subsection (b)(2)(A)—

3           (A) in subclause (II)(cc), by striking “Sep-  
4           tember 30, 2020” and inserting “September 30,  
5           2030”; and

6           (B) in subclause (IV)(dd), by striking  
7           “September 30, 2020” and inserting “Sep-  
8           tember 30, 2030”.

9           (2) EXTENSION OF LIMITATION WITH RESPECT  
10 TO CERTAIN OTHER APPAREL ARTICLES.—In clause  
11 (iv)(II) of such subsection, by striking “18” and in-  
12           serting “28”.

13           (3) EXTENSION OF TRANSITION PERIOD.—In  
14 subsection (b)(5)(D)(i), by striking “September 30,  
15           2020” and inserting “September 30, 2030”.

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
