SIONS OF NONDISCRIMINATORY TREATMENT.—Notwith-

standing any provision of title IV of the Trade Act of 1974 2 (19 U.S.C. 2431 et seq.), the President may— 3 (1) determine that such title should no longer 4 apply to Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, or Tajikistan; and 5 (2) after making a determination under para-6 graph (1) with respect to Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, 7 or Tajikistan, proclaim the extension of nondiscrim-8 inatory treatment (normal trade relations treatment) 9 to the products of that country. 10 (b) TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF TITLE IV.— On and after the date on which the President proclaims 12 the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment to the products of Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, or Tajikistan, title IV of
