A BILL

To promote transparency in health care pricing.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Transparent Health
- 5 Care Pricing Act of 2018".
- 6 SEC. 2. TRANSPARENCY IN ALL HEALTH CARE PRICING.
- 7 (a) In General.—Any and all individuals or busi-
- 8 ness entities, including hospitals, physicians, nurses, phar-
- 9 macies, pharmaceutical manufacturers, dentists, and any
- 10 other health care related providers or suppliers that offer
- 11 or furnish health care related items, products, services, or
- 12 procedures (as defined by the Secretary of Health and

- 1 Human Services) for sale to the public shall publicly dis-
- 2 close, on a continuous basis, all prices for such items,
- 3 products, services, or procedures in accordance with this
- 4 section.
- 5 (b) Manner of Disclosure.—The disclosure re-
- 6 quired under subsection (a) shall—
- 7 (1) be made in an open and conspicuous man-
- 8 ner;
- 9 (2) be made available at the point of purchase,
- in print, and on the Internet; and
- 11 (3) include all wholesale, retail, subsidized, dis-
- counted, or other such prices the individuals or busi-
- ness entities described in such subsection accept as
- payment in full for items, products, services, or pro-
- 15 cedures such individuals or business entities furnish
- to individual consumers.
- 17 (c) Penalties.—The Secretary of Health and
- 18 Human Services may investigate any and all individuals
- 19 or business entities that fail to comply with the require-
- 20 ments of this section and may impose on such individuals
- 21 or business entities civil fines, or other civil penalties, as
- 22 determined appropriate by the Secretary.
