A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow for distributions from 529 accounts for expenses associated with registered apprenticeship programs.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. DISTRIBUTIONS FROM 529S FOR REGISTERED
- 4 APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 529(e)(3) of the Internal
- 6 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end
- 7 the following new subparagraph:
- 8 "(C) CERTAIN EXPENSES ASSOCIATED
- 9 WITH REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP PRO-

GRAMS.—The term 'qualified higher education 1 2 expenses' shall include books, supplies, and 3 equipment required for the enrollment or at-4 tendance of a designated beneficiary in an ap-5 prenticeship program registered and certified with the Secretary of Labor under section 1 of 6 the National Apprenticeship Act (29 U.S.C. 7 50).". 8

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by 10 this section shall apply to contributions made and distributions paid after December 31, 2017.
