Sec. 1. Department of Education to develop support system for MaineCare reimbursement. Resolved: That the Department of Education shall develop a comprehensive system to support school districts in seeking reimbursement for MaineCare-eligible services.

Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That, no later than November 2, 2022, the Department of Education shall submit a report, including suggested legislation, on the development of the comprehensive system for MaineCare reimbursement under section 1 to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters. The joint standing committee is authorized to submit legislation related to the report to the First Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.

SUMMARY

This resolve directs the Department of Education to develop a comprehensive system to support school districts in seeking reimbursement for MaineCare-eligible services. The department is required to submit a report with suggested legislation by November 2, 2022 to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters, which may submit legislation to the First Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.
