A BILL

To repeal certain outdated authorizations for the use of military force, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Outdated AUMF Re-
- 5 peal Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF AUTHORIZATION FOR USE OF MILITARY
- 7 FORCE AGAINST IRAQ RESOLUTION OF 2002.
- 8 The Authorization for Use of Military Force Against
- 9 Iraq Resolution of 2002 (Public Law 107–243; 50 U.S.C.
- 10 1541 note) is hereby repealed.

1 SEC. 3. REPEAL OF AUTHORIZATION FOR USE OF MILITARY

- 2 FORCE AGAINST IRAQ RESOLUTION.
- 3 The Authorization for Use of Military Force Against
- 4 Iraq Resolution (Public Law 102–1; 50 U.S.C. 1541 note)
- 5 is hereby repealed.
- 6 SEC. 4. REPEAL OF RESOLUTION TO PROMOTE PEACE AND
- 7 STABILITY IN THE MIDDLE EAST.
- 8 The joint resolution entitled "A joint resolution to
- 9 promote peace and stability in the Middle East" (Public
- 10 Law 85-7; 22 U.S.C. 1961 et seq.) is hereby repealed.
