Solid Waste Management – Personal Cleansing Products Provided at Lodging Establishments – Prohibition

- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an owner, an operator, or a manager of a lodging 5 establishment from providing a certain personal cleansing product in a certain small 6 plastic bottle under certain circumstances; authorizing an owner, an operator, or a 7 manager of a lodging establishment to provide a certain personal cleansing product 8 in a certain small plastic bottle under certain circumstances; providing for the 9 enforcement of this Act; establishing certain penalties; defining certain terms; 10 providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to personal cleansing 11 products provided at lodging establishments.
