A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO
ESTABLISH A GRANT PROGRAM TO TREAT POLICE OFFICERS WHO HAVE BEEN
DIAGNOSED WITH POSTTRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER (PTSD).

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
Public Safety the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) in nonrecurring funds for the
2025-2026 fiscal year to assist the Department in establishing a grant program to treat police
officers who have been diagnosed with Posttraumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD).

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2025.



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
