AN ACT concerning 1

2 Environment - Recycling - Hotels

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring an owner, an operator, or a manager of a hotel to provide 4 recycling for the guests of the hotel and recycle certain materials on or before a 5 certain date; authorizing a county to require an owner, an operator, or a manager of a hotel to report recycling activities to the county in a certain manner; authorizing 6 7 an enforcement unit, officer, or official of a county, a municipality, or any other local 8 government to conduct inspections of a hotel to enforce certain provisions of this Act; 9 and generally relating to recycling in hotels.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 15
- That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16
- Article Environment 17
- 18 9–1711.1.
- 19 (A) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2024, AN OWNER, AN OPERATOR, OR A
- 20 MANAGER OF A HOTEL SHALL:
- PROVIDE RECYCLING FOR THE GUESTS OF THE HOTEL, 21 **(1)**
- 22 **INCLUDING:**

- 1 (I) THE COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS FROM 2 GUESTS AND COMMON AREAS OF THE HOTEL; AND
- 3 (II) THE REMOVAL OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS COLLECTED 4 FROM GUESTS AND COMMON AREAS OF THE HOTEL FOR FURTHER RECYCLING; AND
- 5 (2) RECYCLE ALL GLASS, PLASTIC, ALUMINUM, PAPER, AND PAPER 6 PRODUCTS THAT ARE:
- 7 (I) USED BY THE HOTEL STAFF OR GUESTS; AND
- 8 (II) DISPOSED OF AT THE HOTEL.
- 9 (B) THE RECYCLING REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION
 10 SHALL BE CARRIED OUT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RECYCLING PLAN REQUIRED
 11 UNDER § 9–1703 OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE HOTEL IS
 12 LOCATED.
- 13 (C) A COUNTY MAY REQUIRE AN OWNER, AN OPERATOR, OR A MANAGER OF
 14 A HOTEL TO REPORT TO THE COUNTY ON RECYCLING ACTIVITIES IN A MANNER
 15 DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY.
- 16 (D) AN ENFORCEMENT UNIT, OFFICER, OR OFFICIAL OF A COUNTY, A
 17 MUNICIPALITY, OR ANY OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENT MAY CONDUCT INSPECTIONS
 18 OF A HOTEL TO ENFORCE SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- 19 (E) (1) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OR (B) OF THIS 20 SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$150 FOR EACH DAY ON 21 WHICH THE VIOLATION EXISTS.
- 22 (2) ANY PENALTIES COLLECTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS
 23 SUBSECTION SHALL BE PAID TO THE COUNTY, MUNICIPALITY, OR OTHER LOCAL
 24 GOVERNMENT THAT BROUGHT THE ENFORCEMENT ACTION.
- 25 (F) THIS SECTION DOES NOT:
- 26 (1) AFFECT THE AUTHORITY OF A COUNTY, A MUNICIPALITY, OR ANY
 27 OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENT TO ENACT AND ENFORCE RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS,
 28 INCLUDING ESTABLISHING CIVIL PENALTIES FOR A HOTEL THAT ARE MORE
 29 STRINGENT THAN THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION; OR
- 30 (2) REQUIRE A COUNTY TO MANAGE OR ENFORCE THE RECYCLING 31 ACTIVITIES OF A HOTEL.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
