A BILL

To authorize the Seminole Tribe of Florida to lease or transfer certain land, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. APPROVAL NOT REQUIRED TO VALIDATE CER-4 TAIN LAND TRANSACTIONS OF THE SEMI-5 NOLE TRIBE OF FLORIDA. 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-7 sion of law, without further approval, ratification, or au-8 thorization by the United States, the Seminole Tribe of Florida may lease, sell, convey, warrant, or otherwise

10 transfer all or any part of the interest of the Seminole

- 6 (1) authorizes the Seminole Tribe of Florida to
 7 lease, sell, convey, warrant, or otherwise transfer all
 8 or any part of an interest in any real property that
 9 is held in trust by the United States for the benefit
- of the Seminole Tribe of Florida; or
 - (2) affects the operation of any law governing leasing, selling, conveying, warranting, or otherwise transferring any interest in any real property that is held in trust by the United States for the benefit of the Seminole Tribe of Florida.
