wounded, but conscious; the victim told Deputy Peck that he
did not know if the shooter was still on the scene, but he had
returned gunfire with his shotgun; Deputy Peck called for
backup and EMS; he then applied a life-saving tourniquet to
the victim's leg; despite their exposed position and the
reduced visibility caused by rain and darkness, Deputy Peck
continued to apply lifesaving measures to the victim until
back up arrived; as a result of the quick action taken by

2	years old and had recently completed his field training; and
