3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 14.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Sec. 14.20.225. Teacher incentive payments for national board certification. (a) In January of each year, a school district or the department, as applicable, may pay an incentive payment of \$5,000 to each teacher who is employed by the district or the department and who holds a current and valid national board certification.
 - (b) The department shall provide sufficient funding, subject to appropriation and in addition to the state aid received under AS 14.17, to a school district to make national board certification incentive payments as provided in this section.
- 13 (c) Nothing in this section prohibits a district or the department from 14 providing additional monetary incentives to a teacher.
