AN ACT concerning 2 Task Force on Recycling Policy and Recycling and Waste Systems in Maryland 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force on Recycling Policy and Recycling and 4 Waste Systems in Maryland to review the Maryland Recycling Act, study the 5 recycling and waste systems in Maryland, and make recommendations on updating the Maryland Recycling Act and implementing regional recycling and waste disposal 6 7 facilities; and generally relating to the Task Force on Recycling Policy and Recycling 8 and Waste Systems in Maryland. 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 10 That: 11 There is a Task Force on Recycling Policy and Recycling and Waste Systems (a) 12 in Maryland. 13 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members: 14 (1)one member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate: 15 16 one member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the (2) 17 House: 18 (3)the Secretary of the Environment, or the Secretary's designee; and 19 **(4)** the following members, appointed by the Secretary of the Environment: 20 (i) one representative of the Maryland Association of Counties;

12 13 14 15	(g) On or before June 30, 2024, the Task Force shall report its findings and recommendations to the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee and the House Environment and Transportation Committee, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article.			
16 17 18	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 6 months and, at the end of December 31, 2024, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly,			

shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
