A BILL

To exempt certain vessels transporting liquefied natural gas from certain coastwise endorsement requirements, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "American LNG First
- 5 Act of 2022".

1	SEC. 2. EXEMPTION FROM COASTWISE LAWS FOR VESSELS
2	TRANSPORTING LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS.
3	(a) General Eligibility Requirements.—Sec-
4	tion 12103 of title 46, United States Code, is amended
5	by adding at the end the following:
6	"(d) Exception for Vessels Transporting Liq-
7	UEFIED NATURAL GAS.—
8	"(1) In general.—Notwithstanding subsection
9	(a), a certificate of documentation may be issued
10	under this chapter for any vessel transporting meth-
11	ane, refrigerated liquid, commonly known as lique-
12	fied natural gas.
13	"(2) Certain vessels excluded.—Para-
14	graph (1) shall not apply to—
15	"(A) a vessel that is owned, in whole or in
16	part, by—
17	"(i) a Russian national; or
18	"(ii) the Government of the Russian
19	Federation;
20	"(B) a Russian-flagged vessel; or
21	"(C) a vessel for which any crewmember is
22	a Russian national.".
23	(b) Coastwise Endorsement.—Section
24	12112(a)(2)(B) of title 46, United States Code, is amend-
25	ed—
26	(1) in clause (ii) by striking "or" at the end;

1	(2) in clause (iii) by striking "and" at the end
2	and inserting "or"; and
3	(3) by adding at the end the following:
4	"(iv) transports methane, refrigerated liq-
5	uid, commonly known as liquefied natural gas;
6	and".
