A BILL

To authorize the appropriation of funds to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for conducting or supporting research on firearms safety or gun violence prevention.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. FUNDING FOR RESEARCH BY CDC ON FIRE-
2	ARMS SAFETY OR GUN VIOLENCE PREVEN-
3	TION.
4	There is authorized to be appropriated to the Centers
5	for Disease Control and Prevention \$10,000,000 for each
6	of fiscal years 2018 through 2023 for the purpose of con-
7	ducting or supporting research on firearms safety or gun
8	violence prevention under the Public Health Service Act
9	(42 U.S.C. 201 et seq.). The amount authorized to be ap-
10	propriated by the preceding sentence is in addition to any
11	other amounts authorized to be appropriated for such pur-
12	pose.
