4 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Advisory Board of the Alcohol Beverage
5 Services of Montgomery County to include a designee of the Director of the Services
6 and a designee of the Director of the Montgomery County Department of Police; and
7 generally relating to the Alcohol Beverage Services of Montgomery County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

This title applies only in Montgomery County.

(a) There is an Advisory Board in the Services.

(b) The Advisory Board consists of the following eight members:

(1) the Director **OR THE DIRECTOR’S DESIGNEE**;

(2) the Director of the County Department of Police **OR THE DESIGNEE OF
THE DIRECTOR OF THE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF POLICE**;

(3) the Chair of the Board of License Commissioners; and

(4) five members who are county residents appointed by the County
Executive with the consent of the County Council.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2023.
