- (a) An employer in the teachers' retirement system (AS 14.25) or the 6 Public Employees' Retirement System of Alaska (AS 39.35) that does not 7 participate in the federal social security system may become a participating 8 employer in the employee benefits program under AS 39.30.150 - 39.30.180; 9
- however, an employee who is a member of the teachers' retirement system may
- 10 choose not to participate in the employee benefits program under AS 39.30.150 -

- 12 (1) THE EMPLOYER PARTICIPATES AS AN EMPLOYER IN
