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1 "Article 18. 2 "Department of Housing and Community Development. 3 "§ 143B-1820. Organization; mission. 4 There is established the Department of Housing and Community Development. The 5 Department shall perform all functions of the executive branch of the State in relation to housing 6 and community development. The Department shall have the following internal structure: 7 Division of Operations. – Provides operations and fiscal services for the (1) 8 Department. 9 Division of Community Development. – Develops and implements plans for (2) 10 community revitalization and for expansion of broadband access. 11 Division of Housing. – Develops and implements plans for housing (3) production and preservation, homeless and special needs housing, housing 12 policy, and natural disaster resilience. 13 14 Policy and Legislative Office. – Serves as the interagency liaison between the (4) 15 Department and the General Assembly as well as other federal, State, and local entities. 16 The Department's mission consists of the following: 17 (b) 18 (1) Partner with communities in this State to develop economic potential of 19 communities and residents. 20 (2) Provide training and certification for building officials. 21 (3) Invest in housing and community development projects in this State to assist 22 low- to moderate-income residents. 23 "§ 143B-1821. Powers and duties of the Secretary. 24 The head of the Department is the Secretary of the Department of Housing and Community 25 Development. The Secretary shall have the powers and duties as are conferred on the Secretary 26 by this Article, delegated to the Secretary by the Governor, and conferred on the Secretary by the 27 Constitution and laws of this State. The Secretary is authorized to adopt rules and procedures for 28 the implementation of this Article. 29 "§ 143B-1822.
