A BILL

To prohibit the District of Columbia Government from requiring individuals to present documentation certifying COVID-19 vaccination as a condition of entering any building, facility, or other venue in the District of Columbia.

1	SECTION 1. PROHIBITING DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA GOV-
2	ERNMENT FROM REQUIRING CERTIFICATION
3	OF COVID-19 VACCINATION AS CONDITION OF
4	ENTERING BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES IN
5	DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.
6	The District of Columbia Government may not re-
7	quire an individual to present documentation certifying
8	the individual's COVID-19 vaccination as a condition of
9	entering any building, facility, or other venue, including
10	an outdoor venue, in the District of Columbia.
