A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Lodging Establishments – Accessible Rooms for Individuals With**
3 **Disabilities – Bed Height**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring each accessible room in a lodging establishment to be
5 furnished with a bed of a certain height; defining a certain term; and generally
6 relating to lodging establishments.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Business Regulation**

20 15–201.

21 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

22 (c) “Lodging establishment” means an inn, hotel, motel, or other establishment
23 that has at least four rooms available for a fee to transient guests for lodging or sleeping
24 purposes.

2 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ACCESSIBLE ROOM" MEANS A ROOM IN A LODGING
3 ESTABLISHMENT THAT IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE AMERICANS WITH
4 DISABILITIES ACT ACCESSIBILITY GUIDELINES FOR BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES.

5 (B) EACH ACCESSIBLE ROOM IN A LODGING ESTABLISHMENT SHALL BE
6 FURNISHED WITH A BED THAT:

7 (1) MEASURES AT LEAST 20 INCHES BUT NOT MORE THAN 23 INCHES
8 HIGH FROM THE FLOOR TO THE TOP OF THE MATTRESS, WHETHER OR NOT THE
9 MATTRESS IS COMPRESSED; AND

10 (2) HAS AT LEAST A 7-INCH VERTICAL CLEARANCE UNDER THE BED
11 FOR LIFT ACCESS.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2020.
