A BILL

To prohibit the Environmental Protection Agency from using assessments generated by the Integrated Risk Information System for rulemakings and other regulatory actions, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "No Industrial Restric-
- 5 tions in Secret Act of 2025" or the "No IRIS Act of
- 6 2025".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF ASSESSMENTS GEN
2	ERATED BY THE INTEGRATED RISK INFOR
3	MATION SYSTEM PROGRAM.
4	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Ad-
5	ministrator of the Environmental Protection Agency may
6	not use any assessment generated by the Integrated Risk
7	Information System program of the Environmental Pro-
8	tection Agency—
9	(1) to develop, finalize, or issue a rule or regu-
10	lation;
11	(2) to carry out any other regulatory, enforce-
12	ment, or permitting action; or
13	(3) to inform air toxics assessments or other
14	mapping or screening tools.
