BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – State Finance and Procurement Section 14–103 Annotated Code of Maryland (2015 Replacement Volume and 2016 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

- 1 A State or State aided or controlled entity shall buy supplies and services (a) 2 from: 3 (1) Maryland Correctional Enterprises, as provided in Title 3, Subtitle 5 of 4 the Correctional Services Article, if Maryland Correctional Enterprises provides the supplies or services; 5 6 Blind Industries and Services of Maryland, if: (2) 7 Blind Industries and Services of Maryland provides the supplies (i) 8 or services; and 9 Maryland Correctional Enterprises does not provide the supplies (ii) 10 or services; or 11 (3)the Employment Works Program established under § 14–108 of this 12 subtitle, if: 13 (i) a community service provider or an individual with disability owned business provides the supplies or services; 14 15 (ii) neither Maryland Correctional Enterprises nor Blind Industries and Services of Maryland provides the supplies or services; and 16 17 the State or a State aided or controlled entity is not required by (iii) 18 law to buy the supplies or services from any other unit of the State government. 19 A State or State aided or controlled entity shall give preference to the (b) 20providers listed under subsection (a) of this section in the order that the providers are listed. 21To the extent practicable, a State or State aided or controlled entity (c) 22shall include in a maintenance contract that has a component for housekeeping or janitorial services, a requirement that a prime contractor procure janitorial products from Blind 23 24Industries and Services of Maryland [when] IF the specified products ARE MADE OR, MANUFACTURED, REMANUFACTURED, OR ASSEMBLED BY BLIND INDUSTRIES AND 25**SERVICES OF MARYLAND AND** are available. 26

  28 PRODUCT THAT BLIND INDUSTRIES AND SERVICES OF MARYLAND REPACKAGES

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 October 1, 2017.
