A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO EXPAND REFUELING AND VEHICLE
MAINTENANCE CAPABILITIES AT THE STATE HIGHWAY PATROL STATION IN
HUNTERSVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1.(a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Safety the sum of six hundred forty-three thousand one hundred fifty dollars (\$643,150) in nonrecurring funds for the 2024-2025 fiscal year to be used for the following purposes at the State Highway Patrol Station in Huntersville, North Carolina:

(1) Six hundred forty thousand dollars (\$640,000) for fuel infrastructure to include an above-ground storage tank, fuel dispenser, FuelMaster Live functionality, and a concrete island with an awning, lights, and electrical outlets.

(2) Three thousand dollars (\$3,000) for an air compressor for filling tires to be located on the concrete island funded in subdivision (1) of this section.

(3) One hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for a vehicle vacuum to be located on the concrete island funded in subdivision (1) of this section.

SECTION 1.(b) The Department of Public Safety shall enter into a memorandum of agreement with the Department of Transportation for the creation, use, and maintenance of the items funded by this section.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2024.
