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## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to authorize the Secretary of Defense to permit dependents of retired members of the Armed Forces who reside in military housing to attend Department of Defense elementary and secondary schools.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Continuity of Edu-  
5 cation for Military Retired Dependents Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EDUCATION FOR DEPENDENTS OF CERTAIN RE-**  
2 **TIRED MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.**

3 Section 2164(a) of title 10, United States Code, is  
4 amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (1)—

6 (A) by inserting “, dependents of retirees,”  
7 after “dependents of members of the armed  
8 forces”; and

9 (B) by inserting “and the dependents of  
10 such retirees” after “such members of the  
11 armed forces”; and

12 (2) by adding at the end the following new  
13 paragraph:

14 “(4) For purposes of this subsection, the term ‘re-  
15 tiree’ means a member or former member of the armed  
16 forces who is entitled to retired or retainer pay under this  
17 title, or who, but for age, would be eligible for retired or  
18 retainer pay under chapter 1223 of this title.”.

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
