- 1 (4) "SCHOOL GROUNDS" MEANS LAND THAT SURROUNDS A SCHOOL 2 BUILDING THAT IS OWNED OR LEASED BY THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL 3 SYSTEM, A CHARTER SCHOOL, OR A NONPUBLIC SCHOOL.
- 4 (5) (I) "TOBACCO PRODUCT" MEANS ANY PRODUCT DERIVED 5 FROM THE TOBACCO PLANT THAT IS SMOKED, CHEWED, SNIFFED, OR OTHERWISE 6 CONSUMED.
- 7 (II) "TOBACCO PRODUCT" DOES NOT INCLUDE:
- 8 1. A NICOTINE REPLACEMENT PRODUCT; OR
- 9 **2.** A TOBACCO PRODUCT USED FOR DEMONSTRATION 10 PURPOSES IN ANTISMOKING OR DRUG EDUCATION CLASSES.
- 11 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN ST. MARY'S COUNTY.
- 12 (C) A MINOR MAY NOT POSSESS A TOBACCO PRODUCT AT ANY TIME INSIDE 13 A SCHOOL BUILDING OR ON SCHOOL GROUNDS.
- 14 (D) A MINOR WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION:
- 15 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, SHALL ATTEND A TOBACCO CESSATION 16 PROGRAM;
- 17 **(2)** FOR A SECOND OFFENSE, IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY NOT TO 18 EXCEED \$50; AND
- 19 (3) FOR A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL 20 PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$100 FOR EACH VIOLATION.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 22 1, 2021.
