To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make permanent the deduction for qualified tuition and related expenses.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Students First Tax
- 5 Deduction Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEDUCTION FOR QUALIFIED TUITION AND RE-
- 7 LATED EXPENSES MADE PERMANENT.
- 8 (a) In General.—Section 222 of the Internal Rev-
- 9 enue Code of 1986 is amended by striking subsection (e).

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 2 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after

3 December 31, 2017.
