Public Schools and Shelters – Homeless Girls and Women – Feminine Hygiene Products

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring each county board of education to make available to certain 5 homeless female students a certain supply of feminine hygiene products in a certain 6 manner; authorizing funds provided by the Department of Human Resources to local 7 administering agencies for certain service providers and to certain service providers 8 for a certain purpose to be used to purchase a certain supply of feminine hygiene 9 products for a certain purpose; providing that certain feminine hygiene products be made available free to certain female residents in shelters; defining certain terms; 10 11 and generally relating to feminine hygiene products for homeless girls and women.

- 16 (2) "FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS" MEANS TAMPONS AND
- 17 SANITARY NAPKINS FOR USE IN CONNECTION WITH THE MENSTRUAL CYCLE.
- 18 (3) "LOCAL ADMINISTERING AGENCY" MEANS THE AGENCY

- 26 (B) (1) FUNDS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO LOCAL
- 27 ADMINISTERING AGENCIES FOR SERVICE PROVIDERS AND TO SERVICE PROVIDERS
- 28 FOR PROGRAMS FOR TRANSITIONAL HOUSING SERVICES, INCLUDING THE
- 29 HOMELESS WOMEN CRISIS SHELTER HOME PROGRAM, MAY BE USED TO
- 30 PURCHASE A SUPPLY OF FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS SUFFICIENT TO MEET THE
- 31 NEEDS OF FEMALE RESIDENTS IN SHELTERS.

- 1 (2) THE FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS PURCHASED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE FREE TO FEMALE RESIDENTS IN SHELTERS.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 5 1, 2017.
