Section 1. Section 26B-7-122 is enacted to read:
26B-7-122. Rules for public cold baths.
(1) As used in this section, "public cold bath" means a tub or tank that:
(a) is used by:

28	(i) the general public, regardless of whether there is a charge or payment for facility
29	use; and
30	(ii) one bather at a time; and
31	(b) contains chilled water:
32	(i) maintained at a temperature lower than 70 degrees Fahrenheit;
33	(ii) of no more than 150 gallons; and
34	(iii) at a depth that allows the bather to maintain the bather's head above the water
35	while in a seated position at the deepest point.
36	(2) The department may not adopt a rule that restricts, limits, or imposes requirements
37	on the operation of a public cold bath.
38	Section 2. Effective date.
