4	(a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi				
5	sion of law, without further approval, ratification, or au				
6	thorization by the United States, the Seminole Tribe of				
7	Florida may lease, sell, convey, warrant, or otherwise				
8	transfer all or any part of the interest of the Seminole				
9	Tribe of Florida in any real property that is not held in				
10	trust by the United States for the benefit of the Seminole				
11	Tribe of Florida.				
12	(b) Trust Land Not Affected.—Nothing in this				
13	section—				
14	(1) authorizes the Seminole Tribe of Florida to				
15	lease, sell, convey, warrant, or otherwise transfer all				
16	or any part of an interest in any real property that				
17	is held in trust by the United States for the benefit				
18	of the Seminole Tribe of Florida; or
