COMMENDING LUKE ADAMS FOR ATTAINING THE RANK OF
EAGLE SCOUT IN THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA.

WHEREAS, commendations and congratulations are
proudly extended to Luke Adams for attaining the rank of Eagle
Scout, the highest rank in the Boy Scouts of America; he
completed his Eagle Board of Review on December 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the rank of Eagle Scout, earned by only a
small percentage of Scouts, involves the completion of an
Eagle Scout Project and represents many years of diligence in
pursuit of a worthy goal that brings honor to the scout, his
family, and his troop; and

WHEREAS, in addition to completing an Eagle Scout
Project, a Boy Scout must earn 21 Merit Badges as evidence of
mastery in various scouting skills, and he must strive to
conduct himself with honor, loyalty, courage, cheer, and
service, the five integral responsibilities of an Eagle Scout;
and

WHEREAS, Luke performed his Eagle Scout Service
Project for Our House, a faith-based, nonprofit ministry that

1 seeks to foster the spiritual, academic, and social growth of
2 disadvantaged children in Auburn, Alabama; with a
3 Christ-centered home environment, Our House's programs include
4 after school outreach, tutoring, nutrition, summer camps, and
5 activities, and the ministry also provides school supplies;
6 Luke corrected drainage problems in Our House's yard by
7 building a bioretention pond to manage the water and to
8 eliminate areas where mosquitoes had bred; in addition, he
9 planted desirable plants in and around the bioretention pond,
10 cleaned an area of the yard that had not been maintained, and
11 replaced a dirt trail with an improved gravel pathway; he
12 successfully completed his project in the fall of 2020; and

13 WHEREAS, Luke is a senior at Auburn High School and
14 is the son of Randall and Jenny Adams; and

15 WHEREAS, through the years, Luke has exhibited those
16 hard-won characteristics of trustworthiness, self-discipline,
17 and good citizenship, all components of the Boy Scout Program;
18 with the guidance and support of his scout leaders, he has
19 earned the esteem of his community, fellow Boy Scouts, and all
20 Alabamians; now therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
22 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That in recognition of his
23 outstanding achievement in attaining the prestigious rank of
24 Eagle Scout, Luke Adams is highly commended, and this
