A BILL

To require the Director of National Intelligence to submit to Congress a report on the death of Jamal Khashoggi, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REPORT ON DEATH OF JAMAL KHASHOGGI.
- 4 (a) In General.—Not later than 30 days after the
- 5 date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of National
- 6 Intelligence shall submit to Congress a report on the death
- 7 of Jamal Khashoggi. Such report shall include identifica-
- 8 tion of those who carried out, participated in, ordered, or

- 1 were otherwise complicit in or responsible for the death
- 2 of Jamal Khashoggi.
- 3 (b) Form.—The report submitted under subsection

4 (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form.
