## A BILL

- To increase the rates of pay under the General Schedule and other statutory pay systems and for prevailing rate employees by 3.2 percent, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Adjustment
  - 5 of Income Rates Act of 2017" or the "FAIR Act".
  - 6 SEC. 2. ADJUSTMENT TO RATES OF PAY.
  - 7 (a) STATUTORY PAY SYSTEMS.—The adjustment in
  - 8 rates of basic pay for employees under the statutory pay
  - 9 systems (as defined in section 5302 of title 5, United

- 1 States Code) that takes effect in fiscal year 2018 under
- 2 section 5303 of title 5, United States Code, shall be an
- 3 increase of 3.2 percent, and such adjustments shall be ef-
- 4 fective as of the first day of the first applicable pay period
- 5 beginning on or after January 1, 2018.
- 6 (b) Prevailing Rate Employees.—The adjust-
- 7 ment in rates of basic pay for the statutory pay systems
- 8 that take place in fiscal year 2018 under sections 5344
- 9 and 5348 of title 5, United States Code, shall be equal
- 10 to the percentage adjustment received by employees in the
- 11 same location whose rates of basic pay are adjusted pursu-
- 12 ant to the statutory pay systems under subsection (a) of
- 13 this section and 5304 of title 5, United States Code. Pre-
- 14 vailing rate employees at locations where there are no em-
- 15 ployees whose pay is increased pursuant to sections 5303
- 16 and 5304 of title 5 and prevailing rate employees de-
- 17 scribed in section 5343(a)(5) of title 5, United States
- 18 Code, shall be considered to be located in the pay locality
- 19 designated as "Rest of US" pursuant to section 5304 of
- 20 title 5, United States Code, for purposes of this sub-
- 21 section.
