AN ACT

- To amend title 38, United States Code, to authorize the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, in awarding a contract for the procurement of goods or services, to give a preference to offerors that employ veterans.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Boosting Rates of
- 3 American Veteran Employment Act" or the "BRAVE
- 4 Act".
- 5 SEC. 2. PREFERENCE FOR OFFERORS EMPLOYING VET-
- 6 ERANS.
- 7 (a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 81 of
- 8 title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding after
- 9 section 8128 the following new section:

10 "§ 8129. Preference for offerors employing veterans

- 11 "(a) Preference.—In awarding a contract for the
- 12 procurement of goods or services, the Secretary may give
- 13 a preference to offerors that employ veterans on a full-
- 14 time basis. The Secretary shall determine such preference
- 15 based on the percentage of the full-time employees of the
- 16 offeror who are veterans.
- 17 "(b) Enforcement Penalties for Misrepresen-
- 18 TATION.—(1) Any offeror that is determined by the Sec-
- 19 retary to have willfully and intentionally misrepresented
- 20 the veteran status of the employees of the offeror for pur-
- 21 poses of subsection (a) may be debarred from contracting
- 22 with the Department for a period of not less than 5 years.
- 23 "(2) If the Secretary carries out a debarment under
- 24 paragraph (1), the Secretary shall commence debarment
- 25 action against the offeror by not later than 30 days after
- 26 determining that the offeror willfully and intentionally

- 1 misrepresented the veteran status of the employees of the
- 2 offeror as described in paragraph (1) and shall complete
- 3 debarment actions against such offeror by not later than
- 4 90 days after such determination.
- 5 "(3) The debarment of an offeror under paragraph
- 6 (1) includes the debarment of all principals in the offeror
- 7 for a period of not less than 5 years.".
- 8 (b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sections
- 9 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting
- 10 after the item relating to section 8128 the following new
- 11 item:

"8129. Preference for offerors employing veterans.".
