A BILL

To authorize the President to posthumously award the Medal of Honor to Alwyn C. Cashe for acts of valor during Operation Iraqi Freedom.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION TO AWARD MEDAL OF HONOR 4 TO SERGEANT FIRST CLASS ALWYN C. CASHE 5 FOR ACTS OF VALOR DURING OPERATION 6 IRAQI FREEDOM. 7 TIME Waiver LIMITATIONS.—Notwith- $^{
m OF}$ standing the time limitations specified in section 7274 of

title 10, United States Code, or any other time limitation

- 1 with respect to the awarding of certain medals to persons
- 2 who served in the Armed Forces, the President may award
- 3 the Medal of Honor under section 7271 of such title to
- 4 Sergeant First Class Alwyn C. Cashe for the acts of valor
- 5 described in subsection (b).
- 6 (b) Acts of Valor Described.—The acts of valor
- 7 referred to in subsection (a) are the actions of Sergeant
- 8 First Class Alwyn C. Cashe on October 17, 2005, as a
- 9 member of the Army serving in Iraq in support of Oper-
- 10 ation Iraqi Freedom, for which he was posthumously
- 11 awarded the Silver Star.
