A BILL

To prohibit the use of Federal funds relating to rejoining the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action with Iran, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Iran Nuclear Deal Ad-
- 5 vice and Consent Act of 2021".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION.
- 7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no Fed-
- 8 eral funds may be obligated or expended in furtherance
- 9 of rejoining the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action
- 10 signed at Vienna on July 14, 2015, by Iran and by

- 1 France, Germany, the Russian Federation, the People's
- 2 Republic of China, the United Kingdom, and the United
- 3 States (including all implementing materials and agree-
- 4 ments related to the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action)
- 5 (in this section referred to as the "JCPOA") unless the
- 6 Biden Administration submits in writing to the House of
- 7 Representatives and the Senate its commitment to submit-
- 8 ting any JCPOA successor agreement to the Senate for
- 9 advise and consent as a treaty rather than as an inter-
- 10 national agreement.
