2 **Baltimore City School Police Force – Vehicles and Firearms – Report**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Baltimore City School Police Force to submit a report at
4 certain intervals to the members of the Baltimore City Delegation to the General
5 Assembly on the condition of vehicles and firearms of the Baltimore City School
6 Police Force and the anticipated needs of the Baltimore City School Police Force for
7 vehicles and firearms for a certain period of time; and generally relating to the
8 Baltimore City School Police Force.

11 Section 4–318(h)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Education**

17 4–318.

18 **(H) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2017, AND EVERY 2 YEARS THEREAFTER, THE**
19 **BALTIMORE CITY SCHOOL POLICE FORCE SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE**
