A BILL

To amend the Small Business Investment Act of 1958 to increase the maximum loan amount for certain loans.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "504 Green Energy En-
- 5 hancement Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. INCREASE IN CERTAIN MAXIMUM LOAN AMOUNTS.
- 7 (a) In General.—Section 502(2)(A) of the Small
- 8 Business Investment Act of 1958 (15 U.S.C. 696(2)(A))
- 9 is amended—

1	(1) in clause (iv), by striking "\$5,500,000" and
2	inserting "\$20,000,000"; and
3	(2) in clause (v), by striking "\$5,500,000" and
4	inserting "\$20,000,000".
5	(b) Report.—Not later than 1 year after the date
6	of enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter, the Ad-
7	ministrator of the Small Business Administration shall
8	submit to Congress a report that details, for the year cov-
9	ered by the report, the industries and geographic areas
10	with respect to which the Administrator has made loans
11	under clauses (iv) and (v) of section $502(2)(A)$ of the
12	Small Business Investment Act of 1958 (15 U.S.C.
13	696(2)(A)), as amended by subsection (a).
